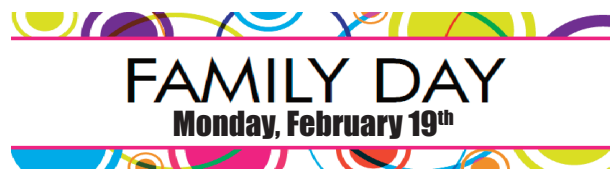
- ◆ Hymn books are available on a cart at the front of the sanctuary for those who like to sing with the notes. All song lyrics will be projected.
