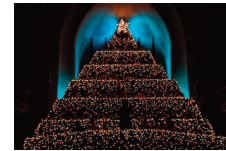
**NEXT SUNDAY'S OFFERING:** "SHEILA DYKSTRA & JONATHAN WEVERINK" Sheila and Jonathan are

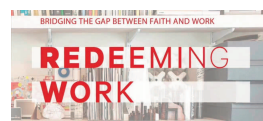
