Renegotiating Faith: Walking with young adults through a critical season in faith formation. The Evangelical Fellowship of Canada's recent research study -- "Renegotiating Faith: The Delay in Young Adult Identity Formation and What It Means for the Church in Canada" -- will be the focus of an evening conversation at Redeemer University College (co-sponsored with CRC Faith Formation Ministries). The report's lead researcher and author, Rick Hiemstra, will present an overview of the report's findings and recommendations, followed by a panel of experts moderated by FFM's Dr. Syd Hielema. The evening will provide a clearer understanding of young adult faith lives and suggest specific steps to take for congregations and families as they walk with young adults. COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS: Council asks the members of the congregation to submit names for consideration as nominees for elder or deacon for the upcoming year.

Annual Inter-Classis Safe Church Conference will be held on **Sat, March 2nd from 9:00 - 3:30** at the Waterloo CRC. All are welcome! Our main speaker will be Bev Sterk from Lynden, Washington, who spoke passionately at last year's synod about abuse and what the denomination needs to do to prevent it. Other speakers include Kathy Smith, adjunct professor of church policy at Calvin Seminary, Grand Rapids, and former crown attorney Henry Van

Drunen. In addition there is a presentation on the "Circle of Grace" Abuse Prevention curriculum, a presentation on cyber-bullying by the Waterloo Regional Police Department, and a session on detection and prevention of suicide. All ministry leaders (pastors, elders, deacons, youth ministry leaders) and those involved with abuse awareness are urged to attend.
