**Annual Inter-Classis Safe Church Conference** will be held on **Sat, March 2<sup>nd</sup> from 9:00 - 3:30** at the Waterloo CRC. All are welcome! Our main speaker will be Bev Sterk from Lynden, Washington, who spoke passionately at last year's synod about abuse and what the denomination needs to do to prevent it. Other speakers include Kathy Smith, adjunct professor of church policy at Calvin Seminary, Grand Rapids, and former crown attorney Henry Van Drunen. In addition there is a presentation on the "Circle of Grace" Abuse Prevention curriculum, a presentation on cyber-bullying by the Waterloo Regional Police Department, and a session on detection and prevention of suicide. All ministry leaders (pastors,
