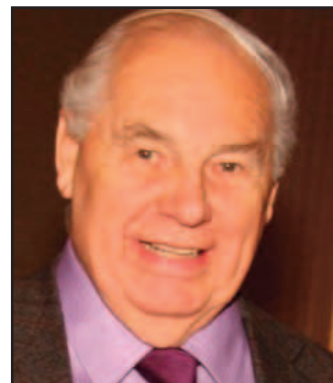

Obituary Notice: Reverend John Gerald Klomps, age 85, went to be with his Lord, peacefully and surrounded by family on Wednesday June 12, 2019 at McNally House Hospice. Born in Aalten in the Netherlands on May 9, 1934. Survived by devoted and loving wife Rita for 59 years. John's passion for people and his desire to lead others to the Lord led him to serve as pastor to Lindsay, Brockville, Hamilton and Mississauga CRC's. In later life John took up the torch for the challenged and served with Christian Horizons in the capacity of public speaker and fundraiser. He served as Executive Director of the Bible League Canada and was instrumental in the development of the Bible for Missions Thrift Store program across Canada. John's passion for travel led him to guide numerous group tours to Israel and many more to Europe and Asia in support of the Christian causes close to his heart.
