NEXT SUNDAY, JUNE 12TH:

Invitation to the Lord's Supper

"Taste and see that the Lord is good;
blessed are those who take refuge in him."
Psalm 34:8



Next Week we have the privilege of joining together at the table of our Lord.

In the Lord's Supper, Christ offers his own crucified body and shed blood to his people, assuring them a share in his death and resurrection. By the Holy Spirit, he feeds us with his resurrection life and binds us to each other as we share one loaf and cup. We receive this food gladly, believing, as we eat, that Jesus is our life-giving food and drink and that he will come again to call us to the wedding feast of the Lamb. (Our World Belongs to God, st. 38)

All who believe in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior are warmly invited to join with us in the celebration of the Lord's Supper.

"Do this in remembrance of Me." Luke 22:19

As you prepare to celebrate the Lord's supper consider this along with your children:

In both Baptism and the Lord's Supper we look...

Backward: We remember the story of God's saving work in Christ by the Spirit, and we celebrate this saving work for the whole world.

Upward: We are in communion with Jesus by the Holy Spirit, even though Jesus is ascended to heaven.

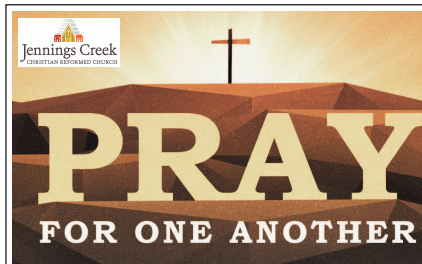
Forward: We already remember and celebrate the feast we will share with Jesus when he returns!

Around us: We see that we are not a disciple of Christ all alone, but in community, in a family, and we encourage one another, just by being together. We seek and desire reconciliation with our family in all cases of offence.

Before us: By his Spirit, Christ is present to us as the One who baptizes, and the One who hosts us at the family table.

And within: During the celebration of the sacraments, we look into our hearts to de light in the ways the Spirit is at work in our hearts to know God, to love God, and to serve God.
